

Lokmanya Mahavidyalaya, Warora (Estd. 1998)

Lok Shikshan Sanstha, Warora, a facilitator of quality education, came into existence in 1951. Since its very inception, the Sanstha has been striving hard to continue its journey towards academic excellence and cultural refinement. Among the host of educational institutions run by the Sanstha, Lokmanya Mahavidyalaya is comparatively a new addition. Established just about twenty three years ago in 1998, the Mahavidyalaya has grown considerably from insignificant infancy to significant adolescence. Its growth, as an educational institution, has witnessed a quality change in the teaching-learning environment of the tribal-dominated township of warora, and its suburb of rustics and less urbane.

Prior to the emergence of Lokmanya Mahavidyalaya, there were colleges in the town which were providing higher education to the young enthusiasts. But they were distantly located and over-burdened. In addition, most of the existing institutions were ill-equipped, insensitive to the varying emotions of the young generation, least prepared to switch over to the new changes occurring in the sociol-educational fabric. There was, therefore, need of a senior college within the limits of easy access, and which could provide quality education to young students, especially, girls and those belonging to remote localities.

Of course, the Mahavidyalaya imparts co-education, but, because of its prime location and its adherence to student-centric philosophy of pedagogy, it is most suitable for the weaker gender. Within a very short span of time, the college has got recognition from U.G.C. under 2(f) and 12(B) sections of U.G.C. Act 1956. Moreover, it has been assessed and accredited by National Council Assessment and Accreditation (NAAC), Bangalore and has got Grade 'B'.

Fully computerized administrative office with the facilities of Internet and uninterrupted power supply through solar-voltic power generating system, spacious library with commendably good collection of quality books, journals and other reading material, a well-equipped computer centre, and a set of scholarly qualified faculties make the college a centre of excellent learning. A well-developed play ground, indoor sports facility and exquisite sports material add to the facilities necessary for the round development of the learners.

General Instructions:

- i. Preference will be given to the students who have participated or wish to participate in the activities undertaken by Kridabharati, Yogbharati & Kala Academy run by Lok Shikshan Sanstha, Warora.
- ii. Kala Academy is available for those students who are interested in learning classical, singing, music and dance. Similarly, Kridabharati & Yogbharati are available for those who are interested in sports activities.
- iii. Admissions sought on the basis of fake documents will be cancelled at any time and action will be taken against such students.
- iv. Every admission form should bear a pass-port size photograph.
- v. While seeking admission remittance of full fees is necessary.
- vi. Students are required to verify their admission forms from admission committee before submission in the office.
- vii. The principal is empowered to finalize the admission or to reject it.

Other Information:

- The students seeking admission will have to submit application form along with requisite admission. documents within the stipulated period of time. The prospectus may be obtained from the college office after paying Rs. 50/-.
- The students seeking admission must have the minimum qualification mandated by the Gondwana 2) University, Gadchiroli and the Government of Maharashtra.
- The students of First Semester will have to pay Rs. 10/- as registration fee. 3)
- Admission Committee of the college will scrutinize the application forms and display the list of the 4) students on the college Notice Board in order of merit. The students will have to attend the interview on the notified date at their own expenses.
- The students qualified for admission will have to pay the necessary fee within the time limit decided by 5) the Admission Committee. In addition, they will have to submit following certificates in original along with their photo-stat copies:
 - a) School / College leaving certificate.
 - b) Mark-sheet of the qualifying examination.
 - c) Character certificate.
 - d) Caste certificate, if necessary.
 - N.B.: Original documents will be given back to the students after the finalization of admission.
- 6) The students who have passed H.S.S.C. examination from board other than Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Education, Pune will have to submit Migration Certificate.
- The students having graduated from universities other than Gondwana University and solicit 7) admission to M.A. will have to submit Migration Certificate.
- 8) The caste certificates submitted by the students belonging to SC/ST/VJ/NT/OBC/EBC/ SEBC/EWS etc. must have been verified by the competent authority.
- 9) The students belonging to Economically Backward Class having annual income less than Rs.8,00,000/- will have to submit freeship form in triplicate. They have also to submit Non-Creamy layer Certificate.
- The list of the students qualified for admission will be displayed on the Notice Board. The student will have to confirm their admission by paying requisite fee within three days, failing which they will forfeit
- Last date for admission will be as per the regulations of the Gondwana University.
- Admission will be given strictly on merit.

i) Other Fees:

- university Examination Fee: The students will have to pay the university examination fee at the time of filling the examination form. Amount of fee is decided by the university, and it has every right to bring about necessary changes in the amount.
- b) Bicycle Stand: The students will have to pay sum of Rs. 25/- as fee for bicycle stand.
- Internet Connectivity Fee: The College maintains language laboratory for free access to learning of languages, especially, English (Spoken and Written). Computer terminals available in the college can accommodate twenty students at one go. Moreover, college provides round-the-clock internet services to the students without charging fee. However, every student will have to pay annual maintenance charge of **Rs. 100/-**.
- d) Available Scholarships: The students can avail of the following scholarships and fee concession on the terms and conditions mentioned below:
 - i) Government of India Scholarship.
 - ii) Freeship/EBC/STC/PTC/Physically-Challenged Scholarship.
 - iii) Open Merit Scholarship.
 - iv) Minority Scholarship.
 - v) The students admitted in the classes run on no-grant basis can avail of only Government of India / Open Merit Scholarship and Physically Handicapped concession. They can not get EBC / STC / PTC / Free-ship concession.
 - vi) The student can not opt for more than one scholarship. Any scholarship granted to the student remains final, and the student can not switch over to other scholarship/concession.
 - vii) The student who is eligible for scholarship must have to open Savings Bank Account on his name in any nationalised bank, preferably, in the Bank of Maharashtra, Warora within a week after his admission.

Various Projects and activities:

- National Service Scheme: The college runs National Service Scheme (NSS) since its very inception in 1998-99. The NSS unit can enrol 150 students at the most. The students seeking admission to NSS will have to pay Rs. 10/- as registration fee.
- 2. Population Education: The scheme of Population Education is run by the college as an extension activity. It works under the Department of Extension and Continuing Education, Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.
- 3. Mahila Adhyayan and Seva Kendra: It is also an extension activity which works under the aegis of the Department of Extension and Continuing Education, Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.
- 4. Student Council: As per the Maharashtra Public University Act 2016, the members of the council are elected from the admitted students. It gives them an opportunity to develop leadership by organizing and carrying college activities.
- 5. Marathi Bhasha Mandal / English Literary Club / Literary Association: Literary Clubs / Associations are framed from students of UG and PG to organize and carry out literary activities such as elocution, essay writing, seminars, guest lectures.
- 6. History Association: It is formed from the students of UG and PG to organize the activities of the department such as education excursion, guest lectures, seminars.
- 7. Political Science Association: It is formed from the students of UG and PG to organize the activities of the department such as guest lectures, seminars.
- 8. Sociology Study Group: It is formed from the students of UG and PG to organize the activities of the department such as guest lectures, seminars.

- Department of Physical Education and sports: Indoor stadium, Gymnasium, outdoor Volleyball and Kabaddi ground are well furnished to develop physical efficiency of the students.
- 10. Remedial Coaching: Remedial Coaching centre organises extra-classes during holidays and vacation. Generally, University Grants Commission provides grants for running such classes for SC/ST/OBC Non-creamylayer / Minorities etc.
- 11. Centre for Preparing the Students for Entry in Services (Spardha Pariksha): It runs classes for the students belonging to SC/ST/OBC Non-creamylayer / Minorities with the grants provided generally by the UGC. It also conducts examinations on general studies for the school / college students of the town and the suburb.
- 12. Career Guidance and Counselling Cell: The cell organises special classes for those students who desire to appear for various competitive examinations conducted by Public Service Commission of Maharashtra and Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi.
- 13. Yeshwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University (YCMOU) Centre: The centre conducts classes for B.A. & B.Sc. Open University. Relevant information can be courses recognised by Yeshwantrao Chavan Maharashtra gathered from the centre. www.lokmanyamahavidyalaya.org
- 14. Alumni Association: The regular meetings of the former students of the college arranged to seek help and suggestions from them to provide facilities that they could not take advantage of. They can also occasionally visit the campus and express their expectations.
- 15. Teacher-Parent Interface: The meetings are arranged to discuss the problems and possible solutions of their wards. They can also visit the concerned staff in office time to clear their doubts.
- 16. Student-Teacher Forum / Mentoring Students : Specific number of students are allotted to one permanent faculty and two or more contributory teachers to mentor and resolve the problems of students.
- 17. College Magazine: The College brings out a well-designed Annual magazine which contains creative, critical and informative articles written by the students. It is an endeavour on the part of the college to give proper outlet to the thought emanated from the adolescents' minds.
- 18. Identity Card: The College provides Identity Card to the students once they are admitted in the college. It is mandatory for the students to carry their Identity Cards as and when they are in the College premises or representing the College elsewhere.
- 19. U.G.C.-N.R.C. (UGC-Network Resource Centre): The College has round-the-clock Internet facility for the students. No fee is charged for the Net-access. Students may come any time during working hours of the college and free access to Internet.
- 20. College Examinations: Before the commencement of every semester examination conducted by the university, college conducts preparatory examination on the similar pattern of the university papers. It is mandatory for the students to appear in the college examinations, and whosoever obtains is liable to suitable punishment decided by the examination committee. In addition, to ensure the seriousness of the college examination, the student who fails in clearing the papers is liable to be fined suitably.
- 21. Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC): It monitors the teaching-learning activity of the college, and ensures quality improvement in the students' personality. In the beginning of each session, it designs a comprehensive spectrum of the objectives to be realised during the ensuing session, and at the end, it prepares a detailed report of the achievements and fulfilment of the set objectives.
- 22. Some Important Information:
 - Roll call of the students is taken by the professors in every lecture, and the record of the attendance for each lecture is maintained. The students will have to be very prompt in attending the lectures regularly. It is imperative

on the part of the student to ensure his attendance in each subject to the tune of 80% of the total lectures conducted. The student will have to take prior permission from the Principal for any leave. If he remains absent for long without proper reason, without prior permission or any genuine reason his admission will be terminated. If a student abstains continuously for 15 days without prior permission from the principal or without proper reason, his admission will be terminated. Without prior permission or any genuine reason, if a student remains absent, he will have to pay fine to the tune of **Rs.5**/- per day.

- ii) The student will have to be present at the time of Physical Test as well as Medical Test. Both the tests are mandatory. The student who will miss the tests will be duly fined as per the guidelines set by the Department of Physical Education of the college.
- iii) The student will have to abide by the rules and regulations of the college.
- iv) Every student will have to respect the sanctity of the campus, and conduct himself in dignified manner.
- v) It is crime to destroy college property.
- vi) It is mandatory for the students to be present in the college activities and participate zealously in the schemes and projects run by the college.
- vii) The meeting / programme / seminar / workshop can not be organised without prior permission of the Principal.
- viii) College organises annual gathering as a regular feature. It also organises Prize Distribution Function. The meritorious and extraordinarily skilled students are suitably awarded. Memento or award in cash or kind is given to the students who perform exceptionally well in study, sports or any other activity organised by the college.
- ix) There is election of students' representatives. Students' Council is formed as per the directives enacted in the Maharashtra University Act 2016
- x) The guardians are requested to ____ llege establishment in order to keep a watch on the performance of their ward.
- xi) The students are directed to look at the college Notice Board regularly for any new information.
- xii) In general, no student is allowed to change the subjectage opted for. However, in exceptional cases, Principal can grant permission for change if he deems fit and that too, within one month from the date of admission.
